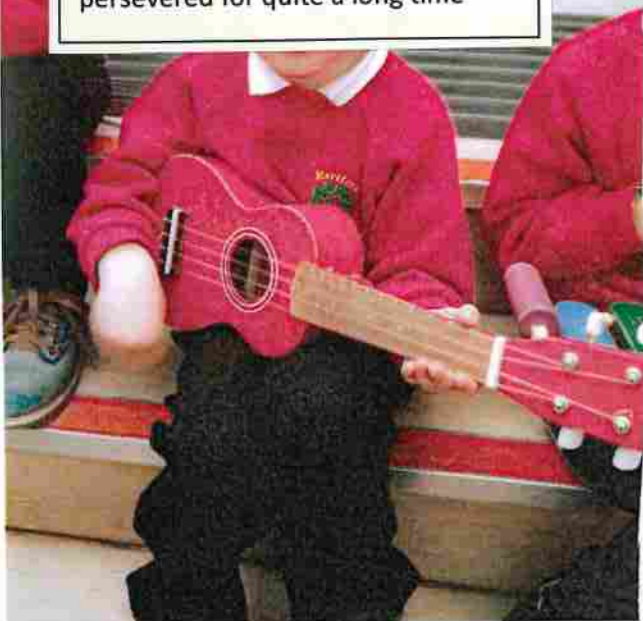


The children selected an instrument to use outside. V found it quite tricky to use the strings to produce a sound but he enjoyed trying and persevered for quite a long time

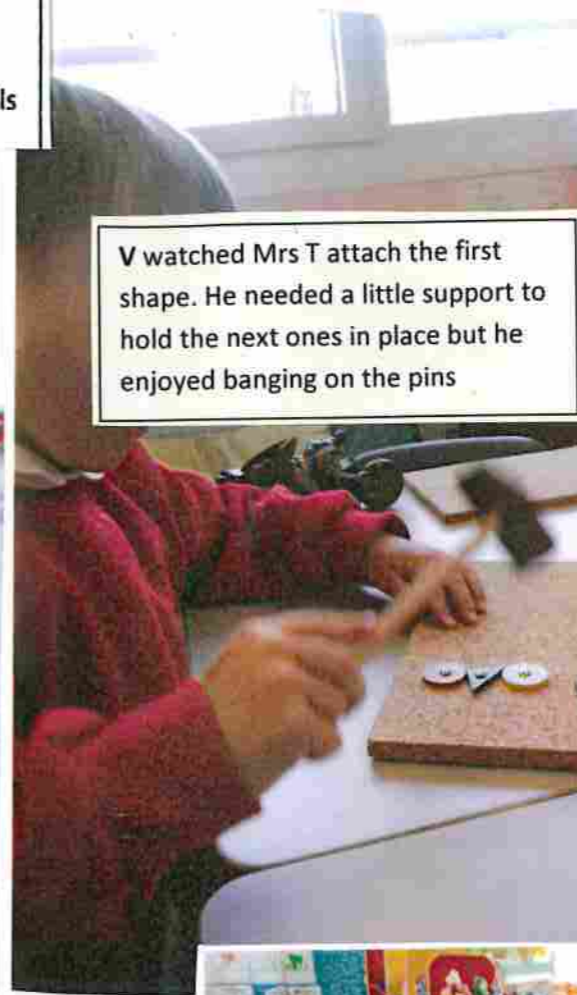

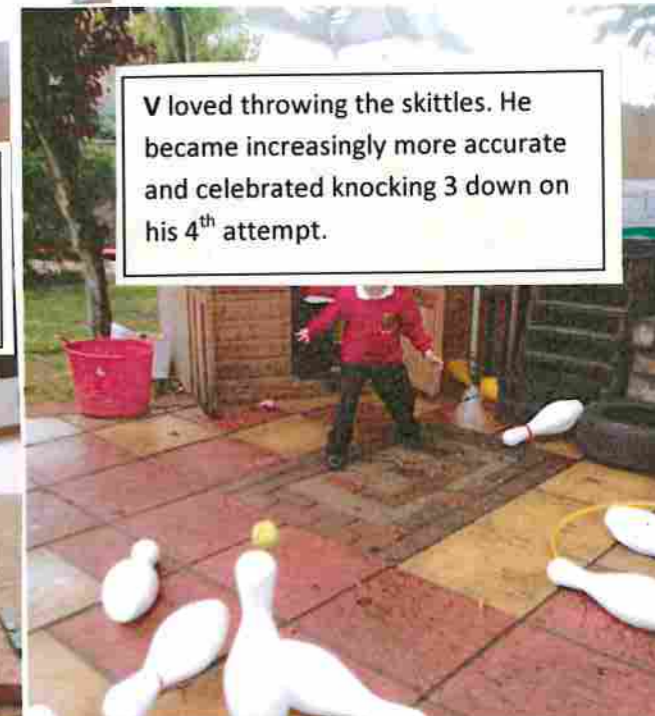
V rode the bike with pedals. He did find it difficult to negotiate around the obstacles.
"I can go really fast"



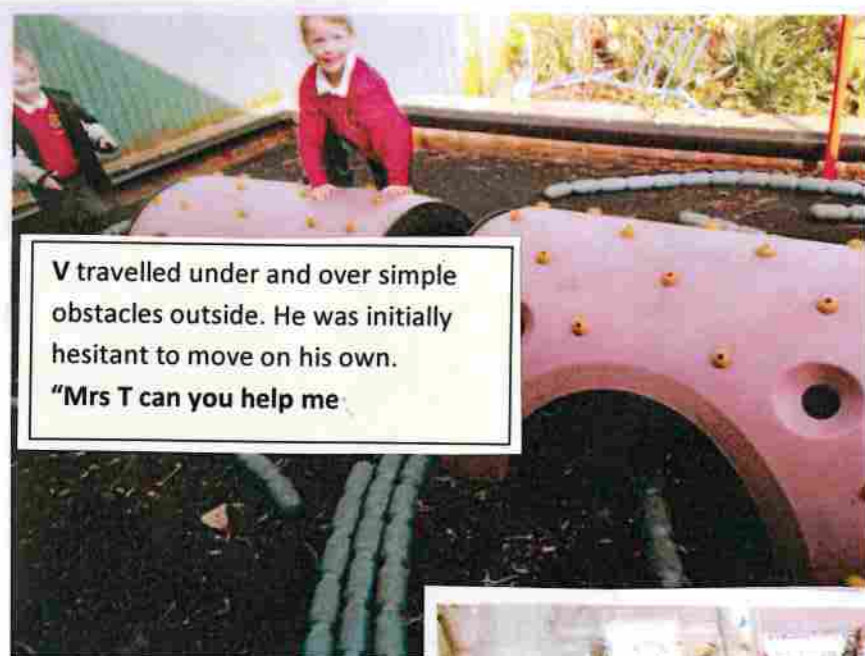
V watched Mrs T attach the first shape. He needed a little support to hold the next ones in place but he enjoyed banging on the pins



V loved throwing the skittles. He became increasingly more accurate and celebrated knocking 3 down on his 4th attempt.



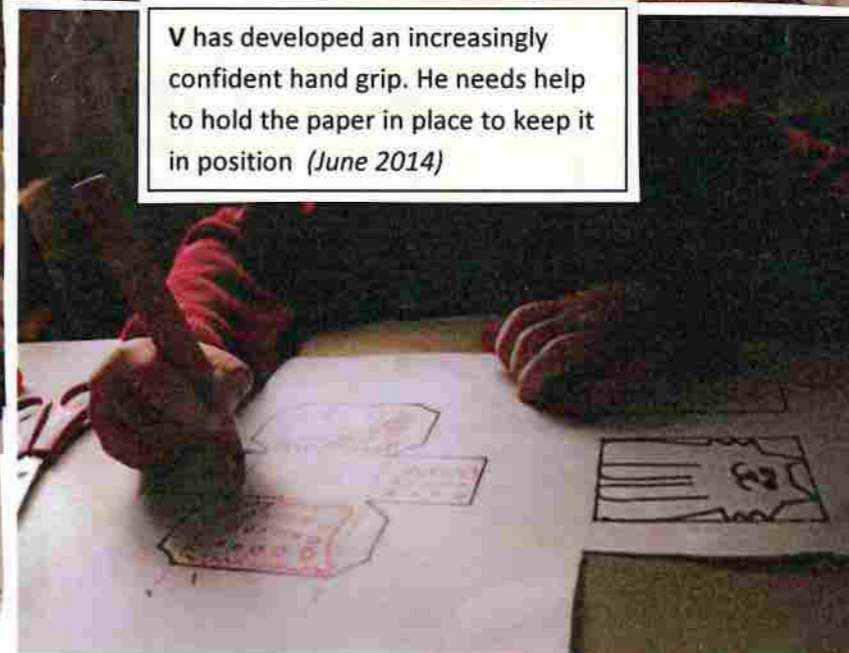
V travelled under and over simple obstacles outside. He was initially hesitant to move on his own.
