Active Learning - being involved and concentrating, keeping on trying, enjoying achieving what they set out to do

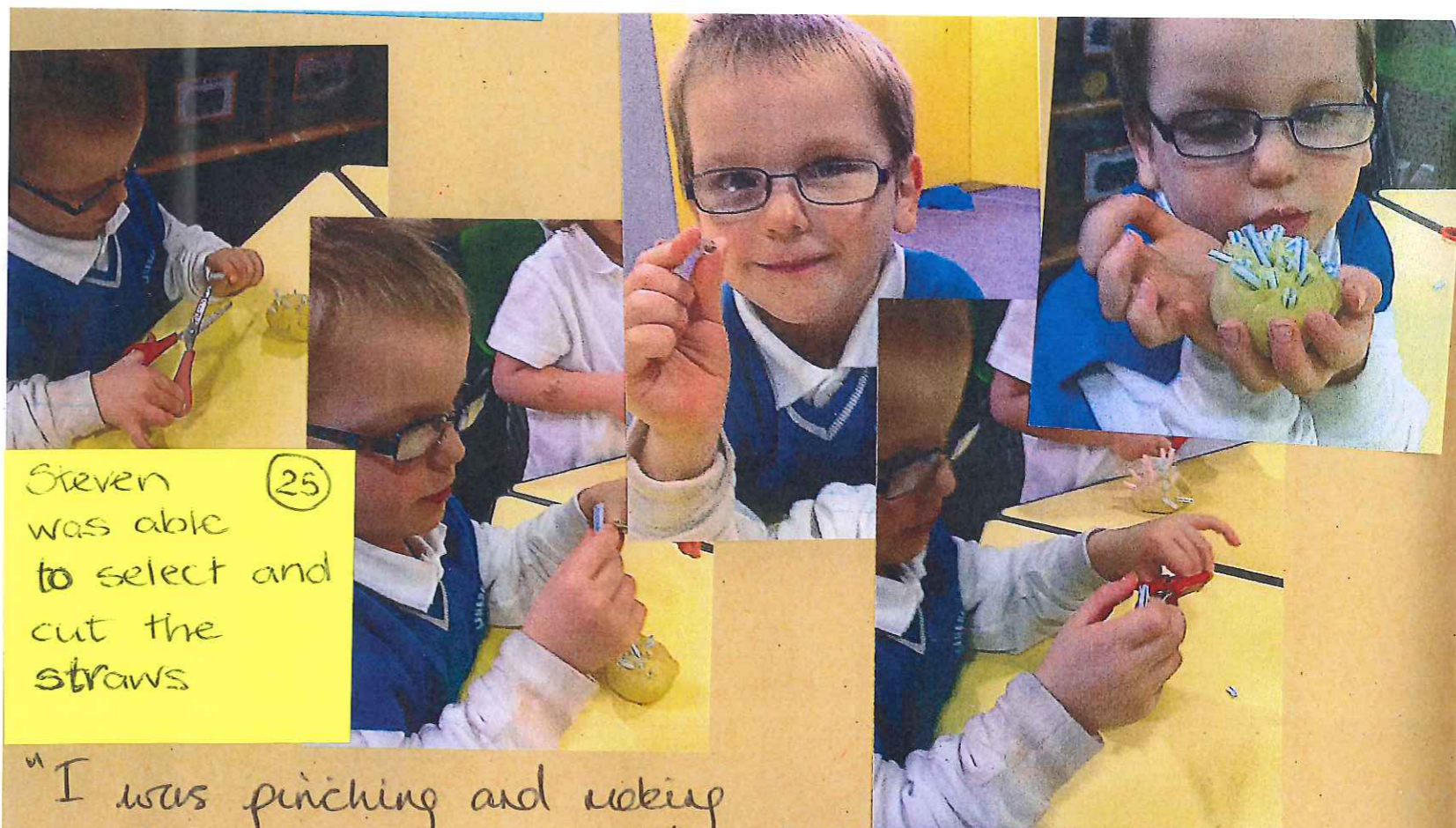
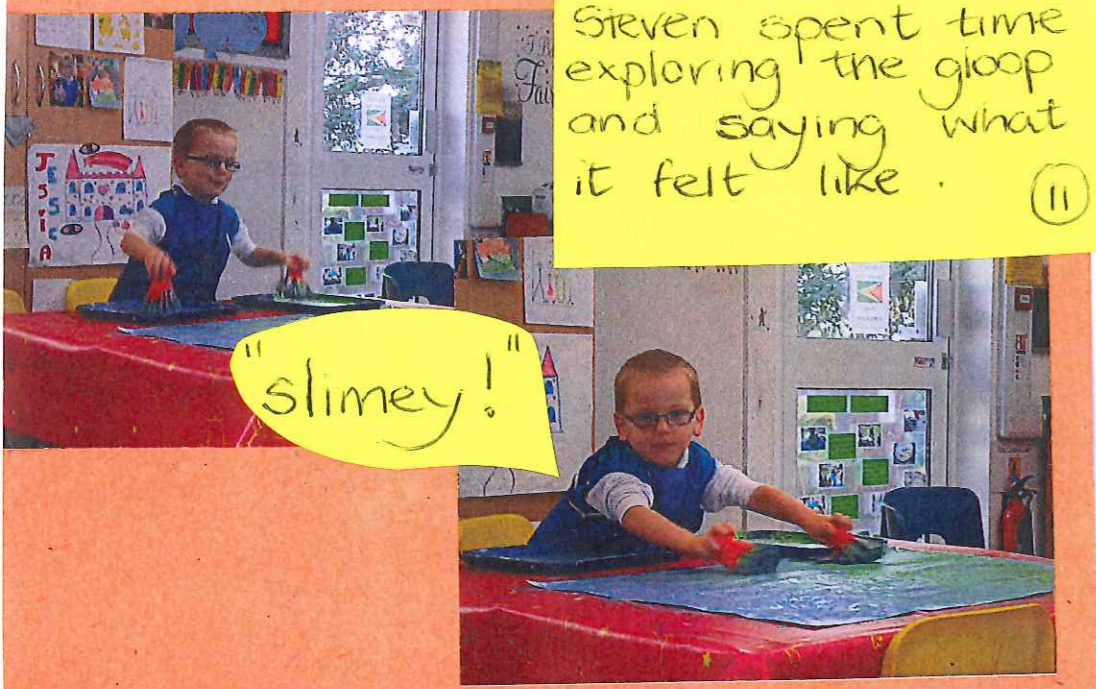
Creating and Thinking Critically - having their own ideas, making links, choosing ways to do things
