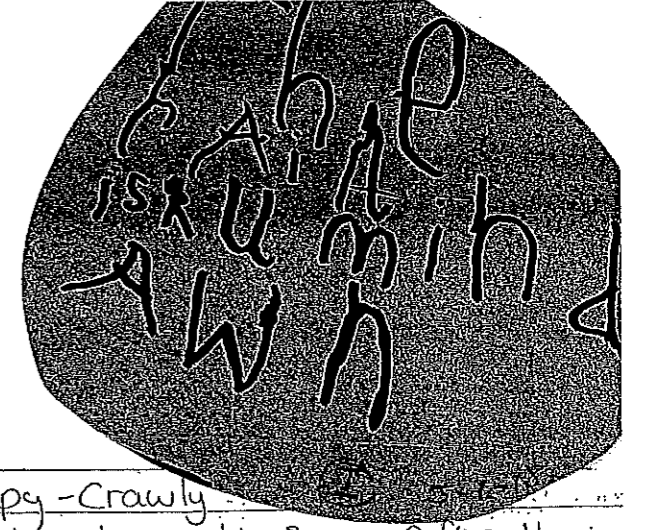

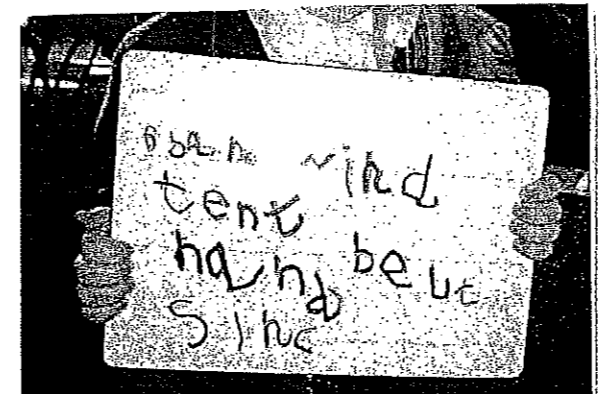
L is always keen to challenge herself and ask questions about her learning. During our Mini-least topic she linked ideas about making butterflies and other insects and chose different ways to make these.

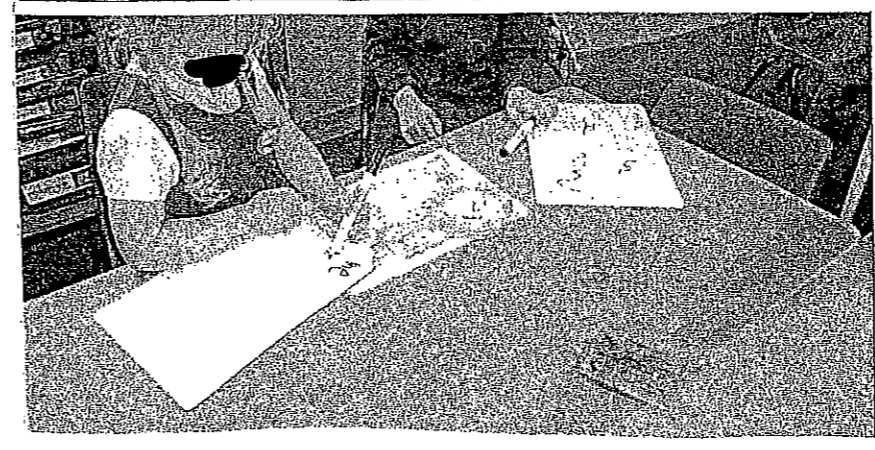
