East Sussex Secondary Schools Ofsted rankings (good or better):

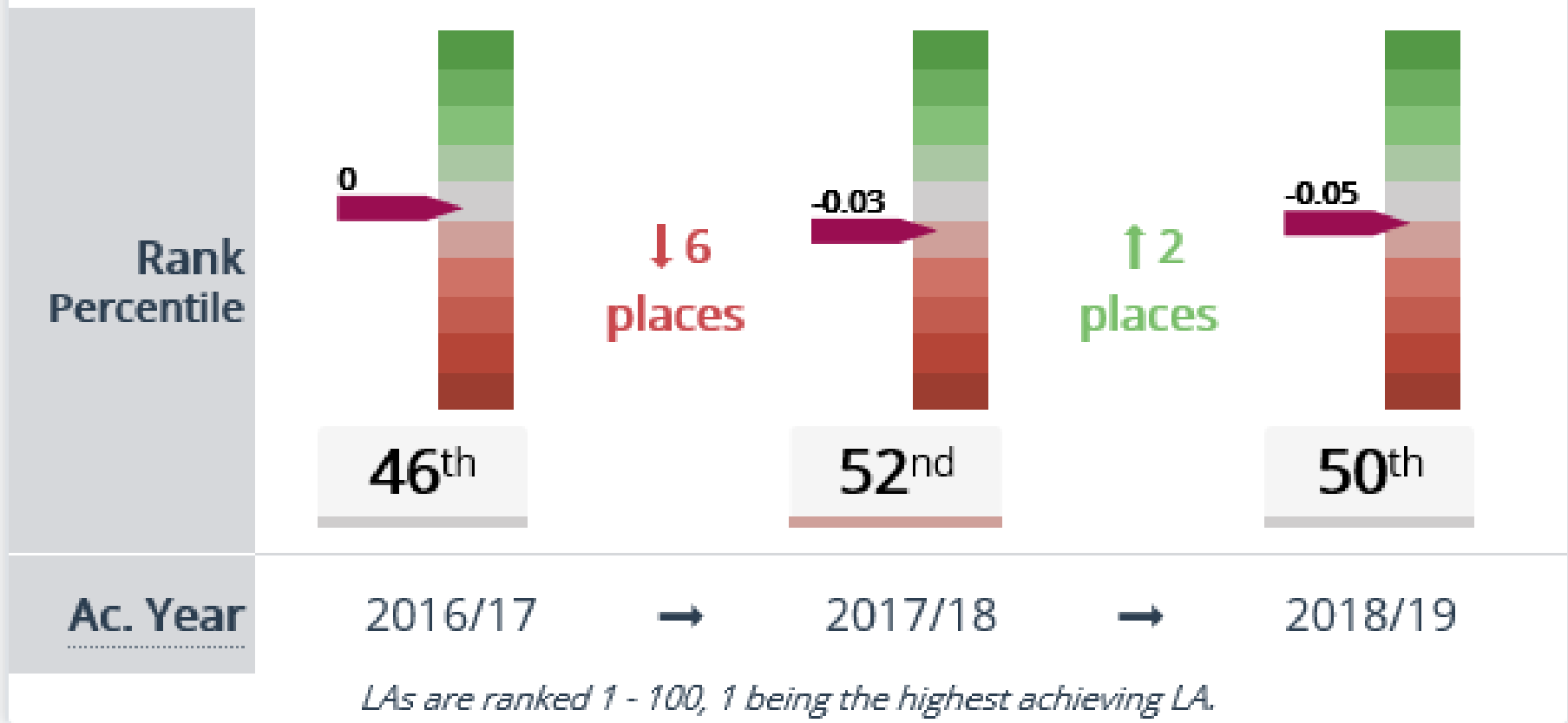
- 2017 : 87th out of 152 LAs

 - Progress 8 Open - below average

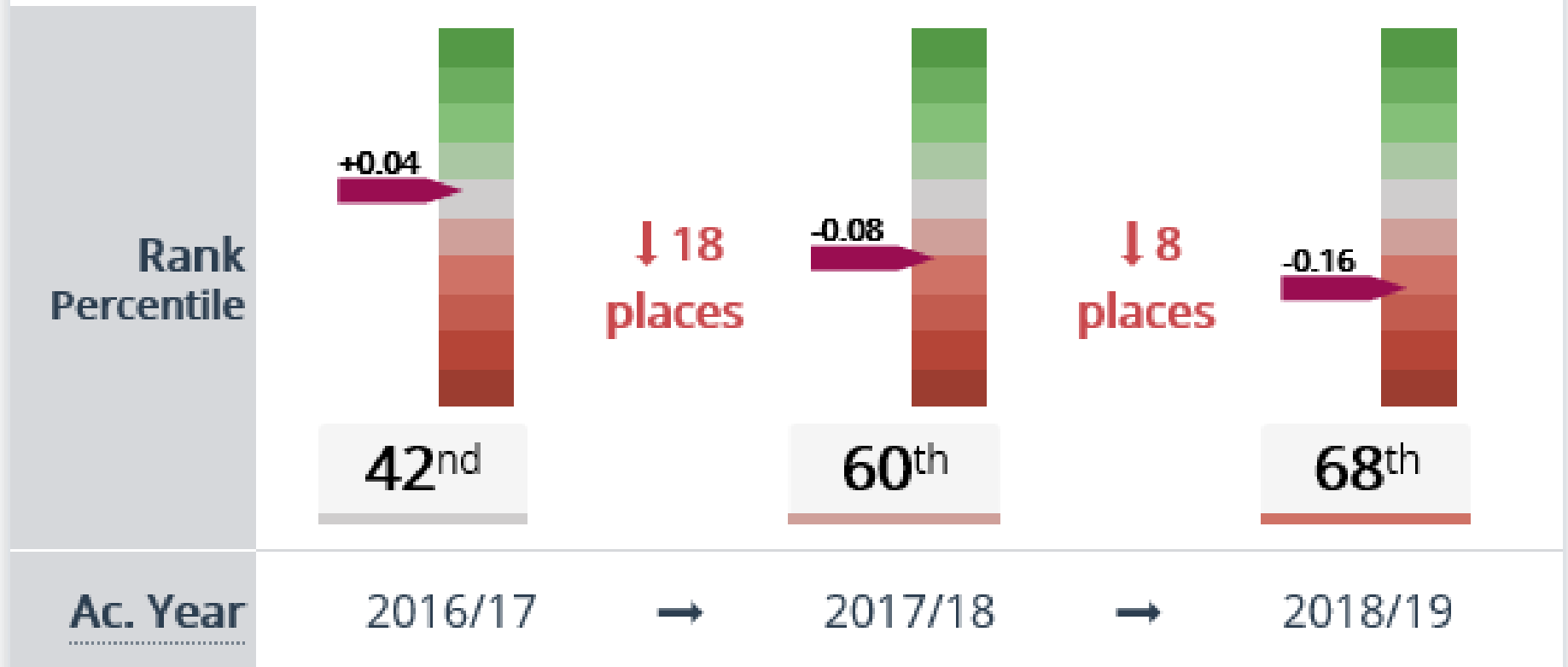

- Ebacc outcomes are closing the gap with national.

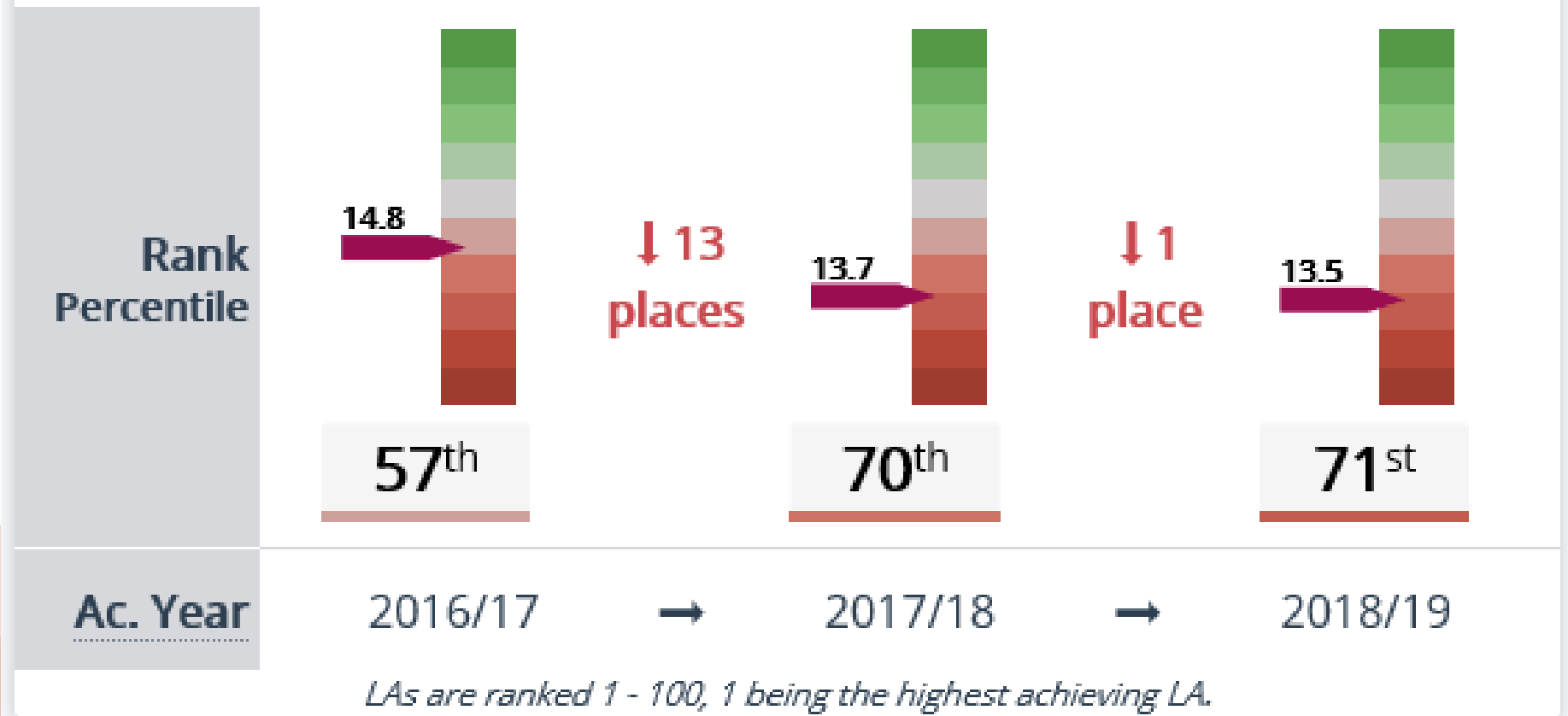

Key Stage 4: Attainment 8 | Percentile Rank Trend

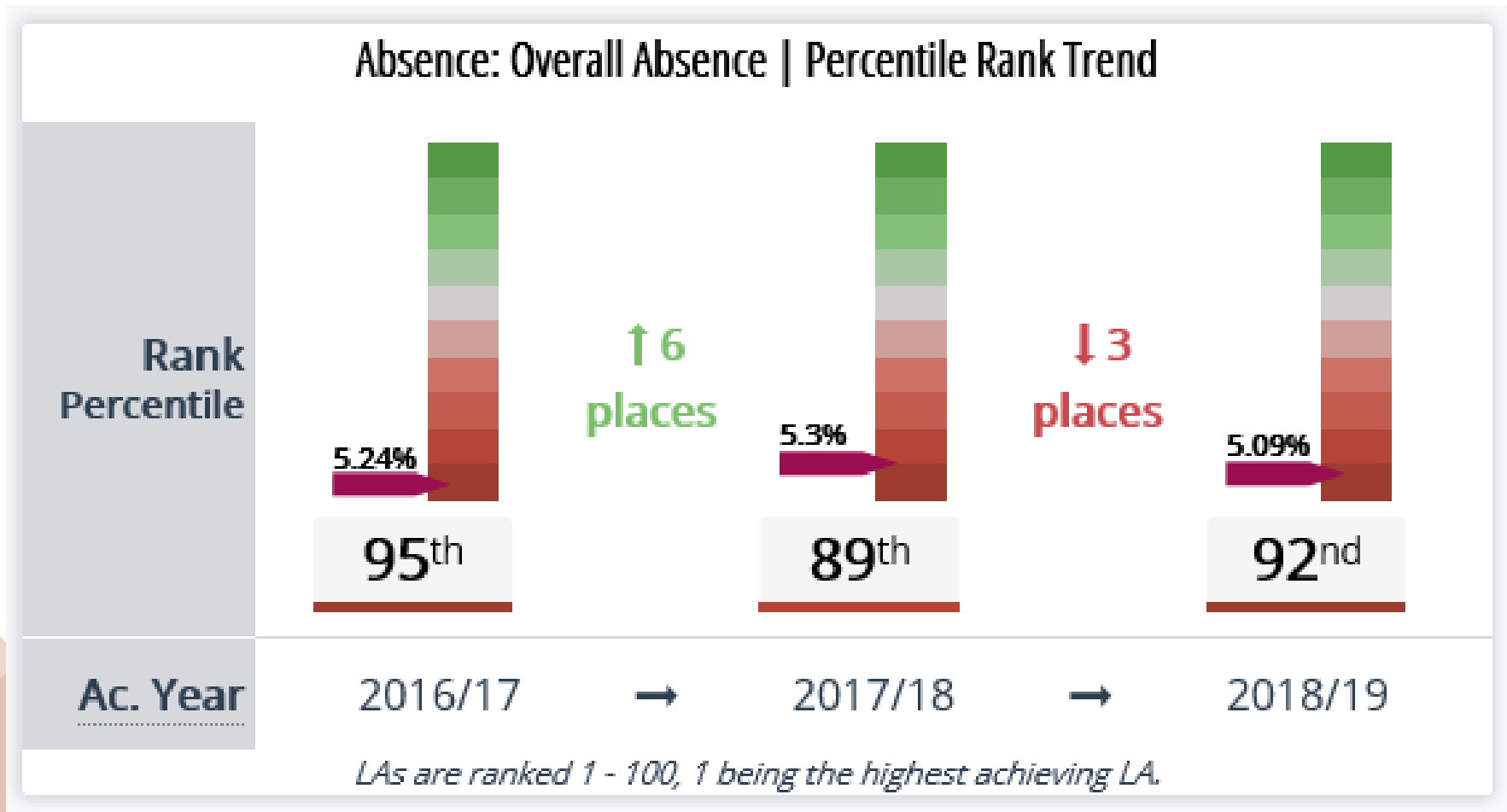

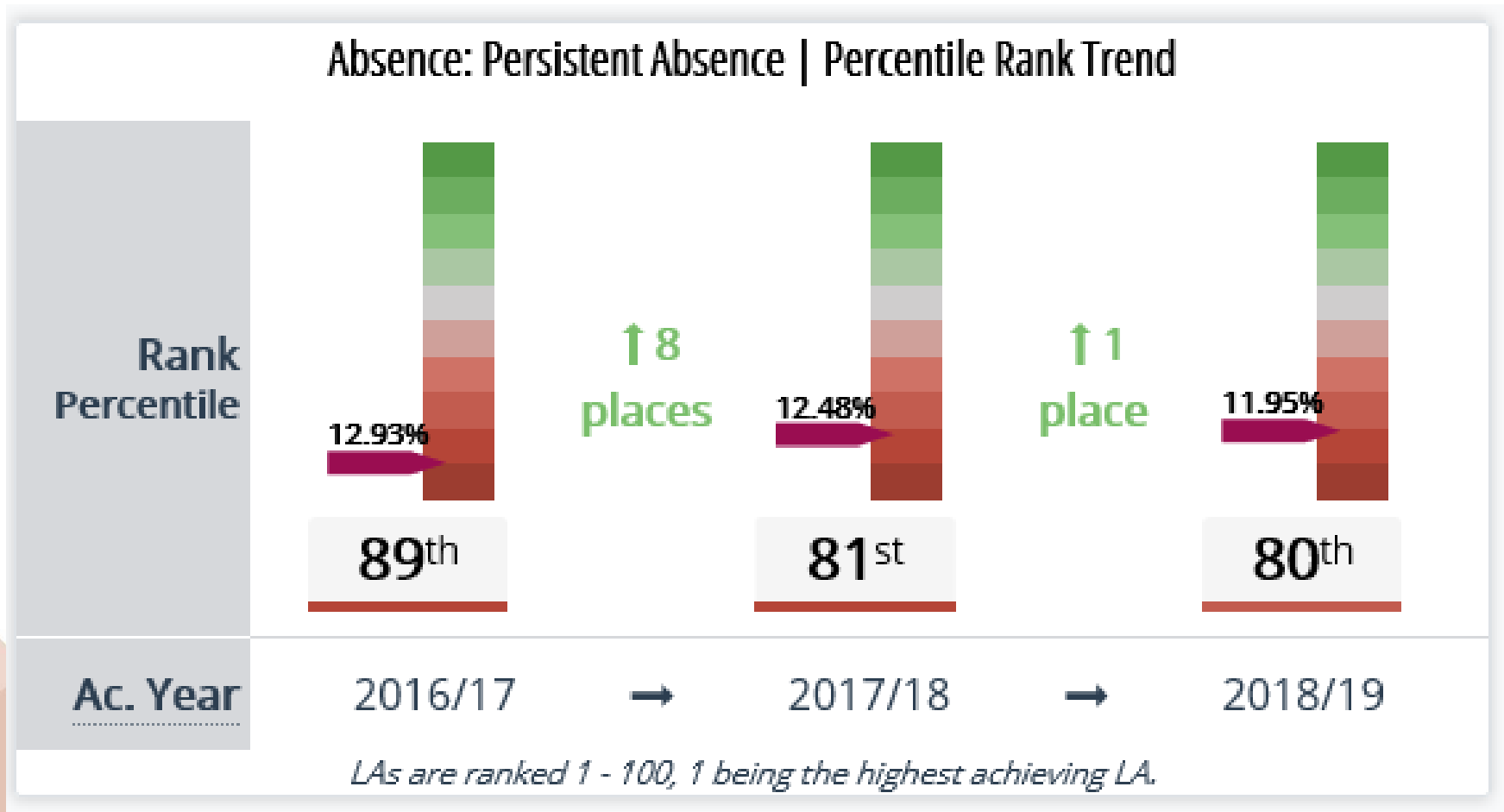
Key Stage 4: Att8: Other | Percentile Rank Trend

Secondary Priorities

- Improving attendance and reducing exclusions, particularly for disadvantaged pupils and those with SEND
- Urgently improve Progress 8 and therefore Attainment 8 with a focus on:
 - Open element
 - English and Ebacc elements
- Performance of disadvantaged pupils
