



Healthy Active Little Ones (HALO) - East Sussex Recognition Award Criteria (Childminders)



HALO Award

To gain award setting must...

- Take part in baseline HALO Health and Wellbeing Check and EBSB Menu Planning Checklist.
- Enable a range of staff to attend at least two different face to face training opportunities as part of core HALO training programme.
- Take part in 5 month follow up phone call and 9 month follow up HALO Health and Wellbeing Check and EBSB Menu Planning Checklist.
- Submit evidence to show how learning from training attended has been cascaded to parents/carers. This can be through submitting two pieces of evidence. Evidence can include parent newsletter, display, documented discussion or learning journal.
- Show an improvement in practice via HALO Health and Wellbeing Check. (defined as an improvement in score in ALL 8 areas of the HALO Health and Wellbeing Check, with a minimum score improvement of 15 points).
- Show an improvement in food provision via EBSB Menu Planning Checklist. (defined as a minimum score improvement of 5 points OR maintenance of 100% compliance OR a less than 5 point score improvement achieved to meet 100% compliance).

HALO Excellence Award

To gain award setting must...

- Meet all of the HALO Award criteria PLUS...
- As part of next steps/intent; plan, deliver and evaluate a health and wellbeing activity/project. (based on identified areas for improvement) and submit a case study that captures outcomes and impact. *Case study template available.*
- Achieve an extra point increase of 10 points on the HALO Health and Wellbeing Check. (Total of 25 points).
- Achieve an extra point increase of 5 points on the EBSB Menu Planning Checklist. (defined as a minimum score improvement of 10 points OR maintenance of 100% compliance OR a less than 10 point score improvement achieved to meet 100% compliance).
- Submit evidence of two-way communication/consultation with parents and carers on two different health and wellbeing areas. *Evidence of two way communication/consultation template available.*
